

## Waterer Outlet Fitting Instructions

Thank you for purchasing a waterer from The Good Life Backyard.

1. Your waterer has been provided to you with suitable sized holes for your waterer cups. To save on shipping and prevent damage to the product, you will need to insert the waterer cups yourself.
2. Remove the wingnut from the waterer cup.
3. The waterer cups have a threaded base. This threaded base should not be wound into the plastic of the tub. Whilst the fit is tight, they are to be pushed in straight, in line with how they will sit when finished.



4. Firmly push forwards. The black section will be tight to push in but will fit. Push until the seal is flush with the tub



5. Put your hand inside the tub holding the wingnut and carefully thread it onto the back of the cup.
6. Tighten the wingnut until the seal starts to squash slightly against the tub. The seal should not be excessively squashed, it works best when gently done.
7. Check everything is done up to a snug level. Once done, your waterer is ready to use.
8. Read the instructions provided inside the waterer. Sit down and enjoy watching your chickens.
